3 easy steps to apply (all on link above):

1. Check availability 2. Apply for Access 3. Order Access AT&T is offering low-cost wireline home internet service to qualifying households:
- With at least one resident who participates in the U.S. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and
 - With an address in AT&T's [21-state](#) service area, at which we offer [wireline home Internet service](#), and
 - Without outstanding debt for AT&T [fixed Internet service](#) within the last six months or outstanding debt incurred under this program.
 - If you are a California resident and at least one member of your household receives Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits you also may qualify based on the same requirements that apply to SNAP participants.

Service availability and speed may vary by address. AT&T will assign you the fastest of these speed tiers available:

- 10 megabits per second, for \$10 per month
- 5 megabits per second, for \$10 per month
- 3 megabits per second, for \$5 per month
- 1.5 megabits per second, for \$5 per month
- 768 kilobits per second, for \$5 per month

- Benefit id card
- An eligibility letter from an authorized agency
 - A benefits

statement Based on Income,
need one:

- 3 consecutive pay stubs
 - Income statement from

employer Or

- Social Security benefits statement
- Veterans Administration benefits statement
- Retirement/Pension benefits statement
- Unemployment/Workers' compensation benefits statement
- Alimony and/or child support documents
